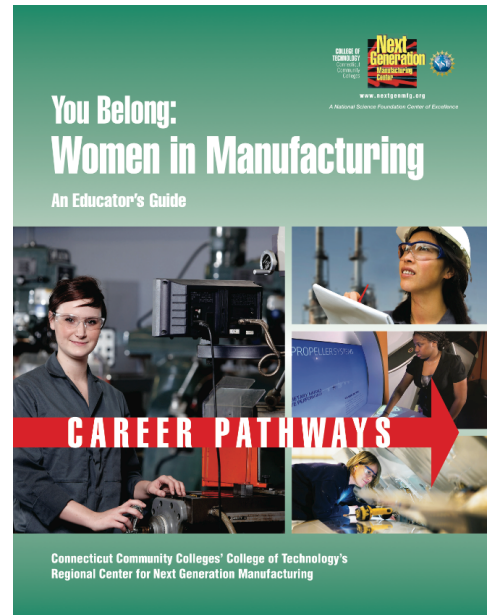


Next Generation Manufacturing Resource Center
